Know What Age Group You Are In:

- Cloverbuds: The member must have passed her/his 5th birthday and be in kindergarten but not have passed her/his 9th birthday prior to January 1 of the current 4-H program year.
- Novice: Ages 9 to 11. A 4-H member must have passed his/her 9th birthday or be 8 years old and in third grade but not have passed his/her 12th birthday prior to January 1 of the current 4-H program year.
- Junior: Ages 12 to 13. A 4-H member must have passed his/her 12th birthday or be 11 years old and in the sixth grade but not have passed his/her 14th birthday prior to January 1 of the current 4-H program year.
- Senior: Ages 14 to 19. A 4-H member must have passed his/her 14th birthday or be 13 years old and in the eighth grade but not have passed his/her 20th birthday by January 1 of the current 4-H program year.

Don't forget the sweepstakes award, for the 4-Hers in each age group who have the most entries.
