Quay County Cloverbud Record Book Instructions and Form



This is the order to put your items in the folder.

- 1. Picture Page on a sheet of paper, glue a picture of yourself and write your name underneath. You may decorate the page if you want
- 2. Cloverbud Report Form The next page of this packet begins your form. Tell us about your Cloverbud activities.
- 3. Completed Project Book Your project book had places for you to write information. If you filled it out put it in your book, so you will have it to look at later.
- 4. Pictures of You Participating in 4-H and Cloverbud Activities Glue your pictures on some paper. You may decorate the paper or put captions under the photo. There is no limit to the number of pictures you put in the book
