Choose a nice folder or binder to put your record book in

Include these sections in this order:

- I. Cover Page is a picture of you and your heifer with names
- II. Table of Contents
- III. Donor Information Page
- IV. Monthly Reports with the last one being the month of August that you are showing in
- V. Catch It Heifer Project Report Form (no more than 2 pages)
May substitute the 4-H project record form and then limit to 6 pages
- VI. Project Story – limit 2 pages
- VII. Project pictures – limit 3 pages

Turn in to the Fair Information Table prior to noon on fair entry day
